With the goal of motivating students with innovative teaching tools, Damon formed the Education Foundation of the Kennebunks and Arundel. Since its inception in 2006, together we have raised over one million dollars!

Your generous support allowed us to fund over \$111,000 in programs in 2016-2017 such as Camp Kieve Leadership School; nationally recognized Lego Robotics teams; the Arts Festival, multiple

musical instruments and programs, as well as professional development for teachers and staff.

We celebrated and honored our founder, Ted Damon, this July at our Spark! event held at Vinegar Hill. Our generous host committee, enthusiastic guests, and engaging guest speakers created a lovely event that honored the dedication and commitment of Ted and the work of the EFKA. As we move into our second decade, I am pleased to share with you that the EFKA continues to expand its reach to our RSU21 students. Each month, RSU21 teachers come to us with intriguing and exciting grant proposals. These staff members are finding innovative, effective ways to engage with their students through programs both in and out of the classroom. Their commitment to educational excellence and to their students' growth is incredibly inspiring. We were able to fund over \$110,000 in a wide variety of grants this year – our greatest amount ever.

Of course, none of these grants would be possible without the passion of the teaching staff and administration and the generosity of our community. On behalf of the Board of Directors, I would like to thank those individuals, businesses, and families who have given so generously and to those who have offered their support through donations of their time, expertise, and services.

During the school year, the EFKA also launched a new micro-grant program, creating a streamlined application process for grants under \$750. The new program, which was based on feedback from RSU21 educators, successfully funded seven grant requests, and we expect the program to grow over time. I am pleased that we were able to streamline our process to enable our educators to take advantage of these great opportunities.

Collaboration between the RSU21 staff, EFKA volunteers, our local community members and businesses provide amazing advantages to our students. Together we give our students and teachers the opportunity to try something new, express their creativity, and broaden their imaginations!
